YEAR 4 – DIG Jorvik Experience
Friday 8th March 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our exciting history topic studying Anglo-Saxons and Vikings, we have organised an enriching trip to visit the DIG experience in York on **Friday 8th March 2024**. DIG is a hands-on archaeological themed attraction created by the people behind JORVIK Viking Centre. This attraction provides the children with the opportunity to become trainee ‘diggers’ to explore and discover exciting artefacts from York’s Viking history.

Alongside the indoor DIG experience, the children will also be taking part in a Viking ‘Battle Tactics’ workshop. During the activity, they will learn about Viking warfare: how they planned raids; compare and contrast Viking weapons; and even join in with some Viking battlefield strategies. It truly is a fantastic opportunity where children can experience history first-hand.

DIG is located at St Saviour’s Church, St Saviourgate in York. Therefore, we will be using a coach to transport us there and back. It is about an hour trip. We will be leaving school around 9:45am and **returning to school around 4:15pm depending on traffic**. Children will be wearing school uniform and must wear sensible shoes for walking along with a waterproof coat.

Children will also need to bring a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles, cans or sweets). Children who are entitled to a free school meal can request a school packed lunch on the below consent. **School packed lunches must be ordered no later than Wednesday 21st February 2024 and are only available to pupils eligible for Free School Meals**. After this time, pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch from home.

To cover the cost of the workshop, we are asking for a contribution of **£16.85** which is payable online via ParentPay.

As pupils will arrive back outside of normal school hours, all children will require a completed & signed day visit form. Please return the attached consent and day visit form to your child’s class teacher **by Wednesday 21st February**.

Unfortunately, if we do not receive enough contributions, we may be required to cancel the visit. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact your child’s class teacher.
