Sandringham Primary School continues to be a 'Good' school.

As you are aware Sandringham Primary was inspected by Ofsted at the beginning of May and the final report has been released stating that Sandringham Primary School continues to be a good school.

We are delighted with this outcome, and especially pleased that the strengths of the leadership team were recognised at all levels along with the impact of the reading curriculum as a key area of strength.

The report stated: *"This is a school that is 'reaching for stars'".* They stated that *"Leaders are raising the ambition and expectations for all pupils across school" and that "these high expectations are beginning to be realised in pupils' achievements. Pupils are excited about their learning and their futures. As one pupil said, 'You can do whatever you want in life'".*

Inspectors also recognised the work of the leadership team acknowledging recent school improvements *"Leaders have made recent changes to the curriculum. These changes are having a positive impact to pupils' learning"*. The report went on to recognise that *"Leaders at all levels have a clear and accurate picture of the school"* and that *"Leaders in school are taking actions to continue to move the school forward"*.

They also stated that *"Pupils feel safe both physically and emotionally. They feel cared for"*.
