Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our science unit for the Summer term, we have arranged for all Year 3 pupils to visit Eureka Museum, Halifax on **Thursday, 4th July 2024**.

Children will depart school via coach at approximately 9am and should arrive back at school for 3:15pm. The children will have the opportunity to have a tour around the museum, exploring a wide variety of interactive exhibits, and gain a further insight into what they have been learning in school. The museum will also be delivering a science show 'The Energy Show' which will link nicely to some work we will be doing about energy, as part of our DT lessons.

All children will be required to bring a packed lunch from home (no cans, glass bottles or sweets) however, should your child be entitled to benefit related free school meals, you will have the option to order a free school packed lunch. School packed lunches consist of a cheese sandwich, a small vegan roll, a piece of fruit and a piece of chocolate crunch. All pupils will be required to bring a water bottle.

To ensure that the trip can go ahead, we are requesting a contribution of **£19.50**, which includes entrance fees, the science show, and transport costs. Payments can be made online via ParentPay.
