This half-term, we have the exciting opportunity for children to participate in a workshop by SMJ Falconry! SMJ Falconry will be bringing in several birds of prey for the children to observe, to complement their topics and bring their learning to life!

The team will be visiting Sandringham for half a day on **Monday 8th November** to deliver educational presentations whilst allowing the children to see these magnificent birds up close.

In Early Years, we are going to be focussing on 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell, and in Year 1, we will be reading "The Owl Who Was Afraid of The Dark" by Jill Tomlinson. The falconry visit will elevate the children's understanding and will give their learning a rich, real-world context.
